


# FAQ: Getting to and Navigating Thru the 2026 PhinneyWood Lunar New Year Event

## Where is the event held?

The Lunar New Year celebration takes place across both buildings at the Phinney Center, [6532 Phinney Ave N, Seattle](https://www.pna.org/locations/phinney-center-campus). Activities happen on the top two floors of the **Blue Building**, and performances take place in the **Community Hall** on the lower level of the **Brick Building**.



## Is the event accessible?

Yes. Both buildings have elevators and accessible entrances with push-button doors. However, the campus is on a hillside and for folks with limited mobility it can be challenging to navigate between buildings. To help, a **shuttle van will run frequently** between both buildings throughout the event for anyone who needs assistance moving between buildings.

## What restrooms are available?

Yes. Both buildings have accessible restrooms. Single-user restrooms can be found on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor of the Brick building and throughout the Blue building.

## Where can I park?

There are a limited number of accessible parking spaces near each building. The upper parking lot by the Blue Building will be reserved for ADA parking and drop-offs during the event.

## Is there a quiet or sensory-friendly space?

This event is crowded and noisy. There will be a designated quiet space available on the top floor of the Blue Building for anyone who needs a calm area to take a

break. There is a short flight of stairs to reach this space. The event is generally quieter during the first 30 minutes.

### **What languages are available?**

The event program will be available in **English**.

### **Visiting with a service animal?**

The PNA welcomes well-behaved service animals on all levels of our building.

### **Seating?**

There is seating throughout all the event spaces. There will be Access seating in front during the dance performances; a volunteer can help you get a seat when you arrive.

**Other:** We are not able to provide ASL, Assisted listening, or Braille support at this event.
